Colorado Inventor to Exhibit “Baby Showers” at America’s Largest Invention Show

PITTSBURGH...InventHelp’s INPEX®, America’s Largest Invention Trade Show, announces that Priscilla Lucas, from Aurora, Colo., has invented a baby bathtub attachment that would continuously pump water to keep a baby warm and comfortable during bath time. This patent-pending invention will be exhibited at INPEX® 2008, June 11-14, in downtown Pittsburgh.

Bath time with an infant or small child can be a trying experience, especially if the baby is cold or uncomfortable. “Baby Showers” would attach to the existing bathtub, and through a system of small hoses and pumps, would trickle water onto the baby’s sides, and down behind the baby’s head and neck continuously throughout the bath. This would help to keep the baby warm and comfortable while being bathed, and would also free up the parent’s hands to be able to fully attend to the baby. The sound of trickling water could also soothe the baby, relaxing them, and would make for an easier transition into bedtime.

Baby Showers would snap onto the existing infant bath tub. To use, a parent would simply fill the tub as normal, place the tub in the water and then turn on the submersible pump. This pump would draw the warm water through the rubber hose and out of the three, small sprinkler/fountain heads. Baby Showers could be designed with different colors to match bathroom or baby décor.

The inventor was inspired to come up with this idea by bathing her own daughter. “I tried to keep her warm at all times during the bath, and found it impossible to do so safely,” she said. “With Baby Showers, I can use both of my hands to bathe her and she still stays warm and comfortable.”
