New York Inventors to Exhibit “PCW - Portable Carpentry Workshop” at America’s Largest Invention Show

For carpenters or other contractors, half the battle is setting up and dismantling tools for the day. It’s a big waste of time when they could be cutting, sawing and building. The “PCW - Portable Carpentry Workshop” would be an all-in-one workshop that would require no set-up or dismantling after use. The invention would have plenty of storage space for other hand tools or equipment, and it could cut down on the number of people to cut full sheets of plywood and lumber. According to the inventor, it would save time and labor on the jobsite, and the product can also be stored away easily when not in use.

The PCW would be a rolling cart that would include space for a table saw, a miter saw and a router (tools not included). It would also feature personal storage, and would include several necessities such as dust collection, a work light and a fold-out table for drawings. To use, an individual simply rolls the cart onto the jobsite, plugs the included plug and power strip into an outlet and gets to work. The inventors were inspired to come up with this idea from their days on the job. “Working as a carpenter and setting up and dismantling tools every day was a pain,” said one inventor. “We saw a need for an all-in-one workshop that never needed to be set up or dismantled.”
