Ohio Inventors to Exhibit “Trim Mate” at America’s Largest Invention Show

One of the big, painstaking chores is dealing with the weeds. Two inventors thought of an idea called The Trim Mate, which attaches to the shaft of the weed eater for better control and balance.

The Trim Mate consists of steel and extends in height from 19-1/2 to 26 inches, is 14-1/2 inches wide and weighs 5 pounds, 14 ounces. The boomerang and V-shaped attachment adjusts to a users’ height and alleviates prolonged lifting. This feature helps a user to avoid injury to their neck, shoulders, arms and back. According to the inventors, the Trim Mate is ideal for homeowners and those who have suffered shoulder, elbow or back injury.

The inventors were inspired to think of their invention because of personal needs. “I had rotator cuff surgery on both of my shoulders, and my wife has a herniated disc,” said Wiebe. “I have tennis elbow,” said Cowhick. “We developed this invention to meet all of our needs.”
