- Abadi LNG: Entered the FEED phase in August and is well in progress. Ensuring competition among contractors by implementing dual FEED for FPSO and Onshore LNG facility

- Achieved cumulative 9-months profit of 293.4 billion yen, up +3.9 billion yen YoY
- Foreign exchange gains of 24.3bn yen recognized, following the paid-in capital reductions of the equity interest in the Ichthys related subsidiary (Details on page 19)
- The full-year profit forecast has been revised upward by 20 billion yen to **390 billion yen** from the previous forecast

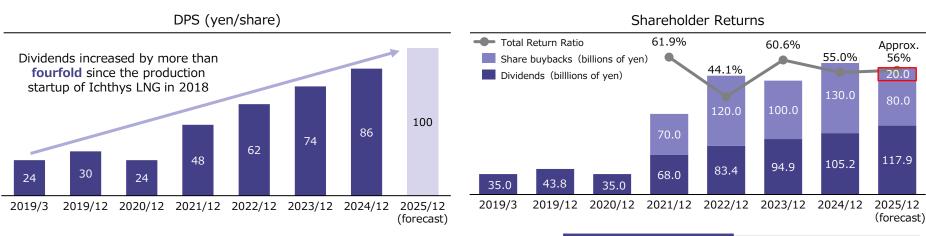

Resolved an additional share buyback of 20 billion yen for FY2025, in view of the still discounted share price level and a revised full-year profit forecast. Since 2022, despite the declining trend in oil prices, **the amount of shareholder returns remains at a high level,** as a result of a combination of increased DPS and share buybacks.

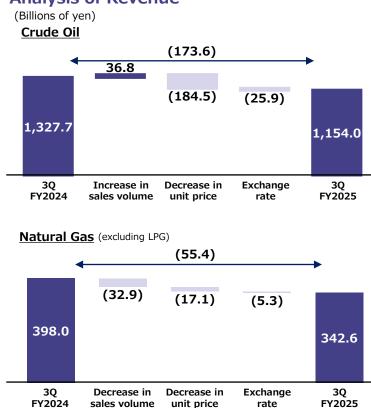

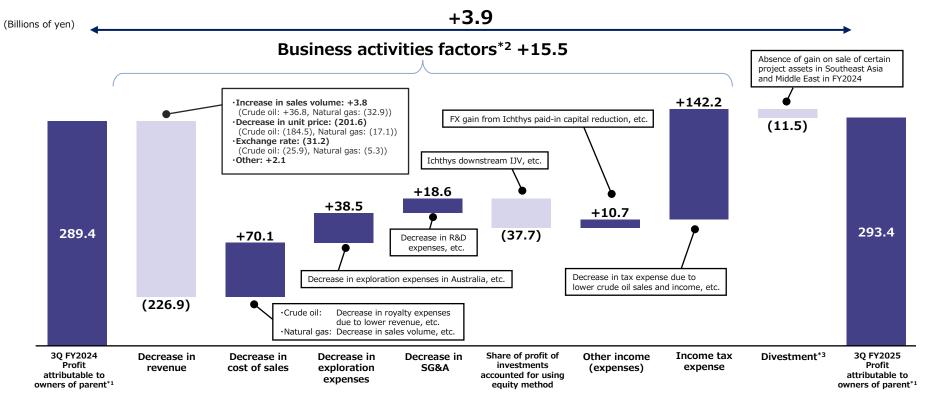




Consolidated Financial Results for the nine months ended September 30, 2025 Analysis of Profit (3Q FY2024 vs. 3Q FY2025)



Despite a decrease in revenue due to lower oil prices and yen appreciation, a reduction in income tax expense contributed, resulting in a **profit of ¥293.4 billion** for the third quarter of FY2025, **up by ¥3.9 billion** compared to the third quarter of FY2024.

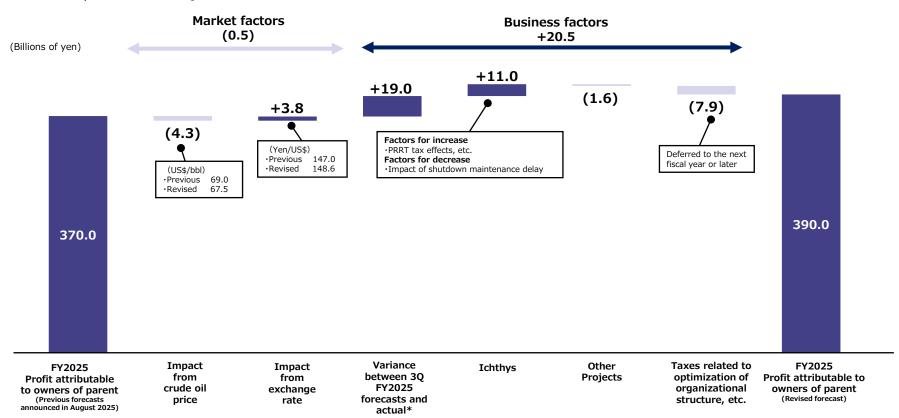

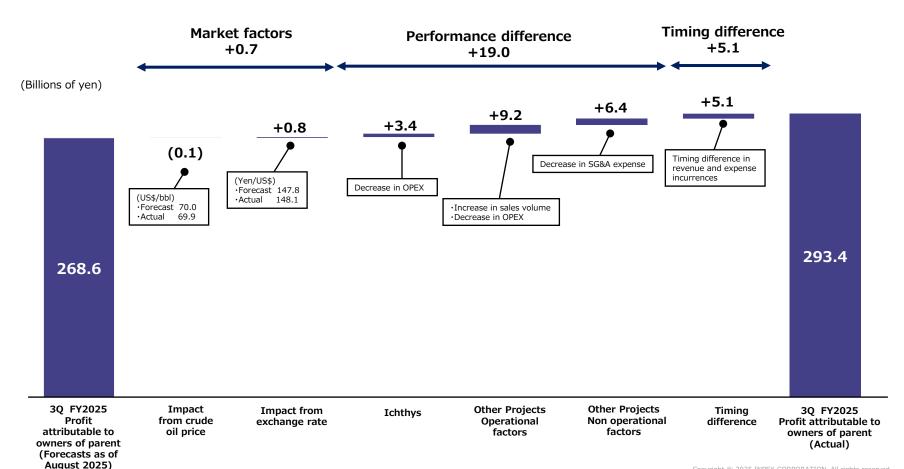

A planned shutdown maintenance has been carried out since mid-August. Production halt continued until the end of September and no cargoes were shipped in September.

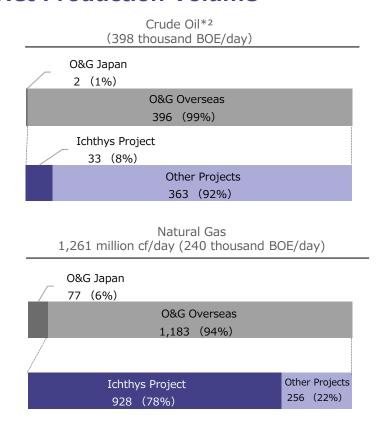
Train 1 resumed production at the end of September. Train 2 resumed production at the beginning of November following a slight delay. All maintenance work has been completed.

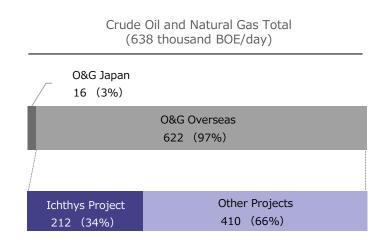

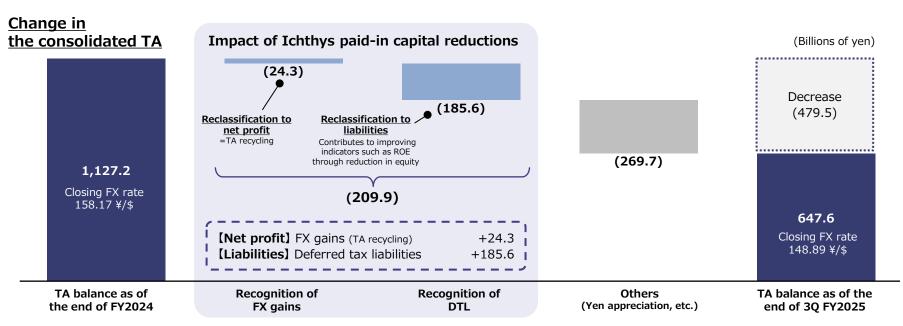

Ichthys Paid-in Capital Reductions

Foreign exchange gains and **deferred tax liabilities** were recognized in the current period, following the paid-in capital reductions of the equity interest in INPEX Holdings Australia Pty Ltd, which constitutes **the Ichthys LNG Project**. These paid-in capital reductions were carried out to strategically secure investment funds for **the Abadi LNG Project**, aimed at commencing production in the early 2030s.

- The impact of reclassifying the cumulative exchange differences on translation of foreign operations from equity to net profit (TA recycling) in connection with the paid-in capital reductions: **FX gains +24.3 billion yen**, TA (24.3) billion yen
- Recognition of deferred taxes related to paid-in capital reductions expected in the future under our group's capital policy : DTL +185.6 billion yen, TA (185.6) billion yen
