INPEX Wins IR Good Visual Award for Second Consecutive Year



INPEX announced that it was presented the IR Good Visual Award for the second consecutive year at the 13th IR Good Visual Awards organized by the IR Good Visual Award Executive Committee consisting of Value Create Inc. and the Japan Investor Relations Association.

The awards evaluate and recognize outstanding investor relations (IR) presentation content issued by listed companies in Japan with a focus on single presentation slides that effectively communicates corporate value. The objective of the awards is to provide guidance to IR professionals by showcasing the slides of awarded companies.

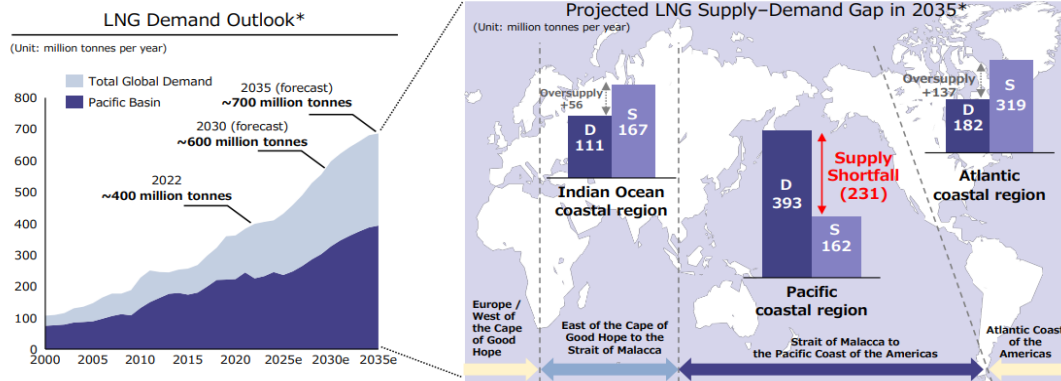
A record 69 companies participated in the 13th edition of the awards, where seven companies including INPEX were awarded.

INPEX's winning slide as shown below is extracted from "[Presentation Slides for Financial Results for the Year Ended December 31, 2025](#)" released on February 12, 2026. The slide illustrates INPEX's strong positioning to capture future growth opportunities by leveraging its strong network across Asia and Oceania against the backdrop of a significant projected shortage of LNG in Asia by 2035 amid rapid growth in the region.

Business Overview
LNG Supply and Demand Outlook



Global LNG demand in 2035 is expected to increase from the current level of approximately 400 million tonnes per annum to **around 700 million tonnes**. Demand will be **concentrated in the Asia–Oceania region**, accounting for about 60% of the total. **Supply shortfall is expected in the Pacific coastal region, including Asia.**
