## **INPEX Holds Facility Tours for Shareholders**

The tours followed the format of the previous autumn tours and consisted of morning and afternoon sessions held on both days, to provide more shareholders with the opportunity to participate. Approximately 160 shareholders in total attended the tours, which were concluded successfully.
